### 1 Vancouver ~ Okanagan ~ Winery ~ Salmon Arm/Vernon (L/D)

We will start our journey via the trans-Canada highway and head east for Kelowna, the heart of the Okanagan Valley. Stop at the renowned winery to learn about the basics of wine making. ### 3 Lake Louise(Jewel of the Rockies) ~ Vernon/Salmon Arm (L/D)
